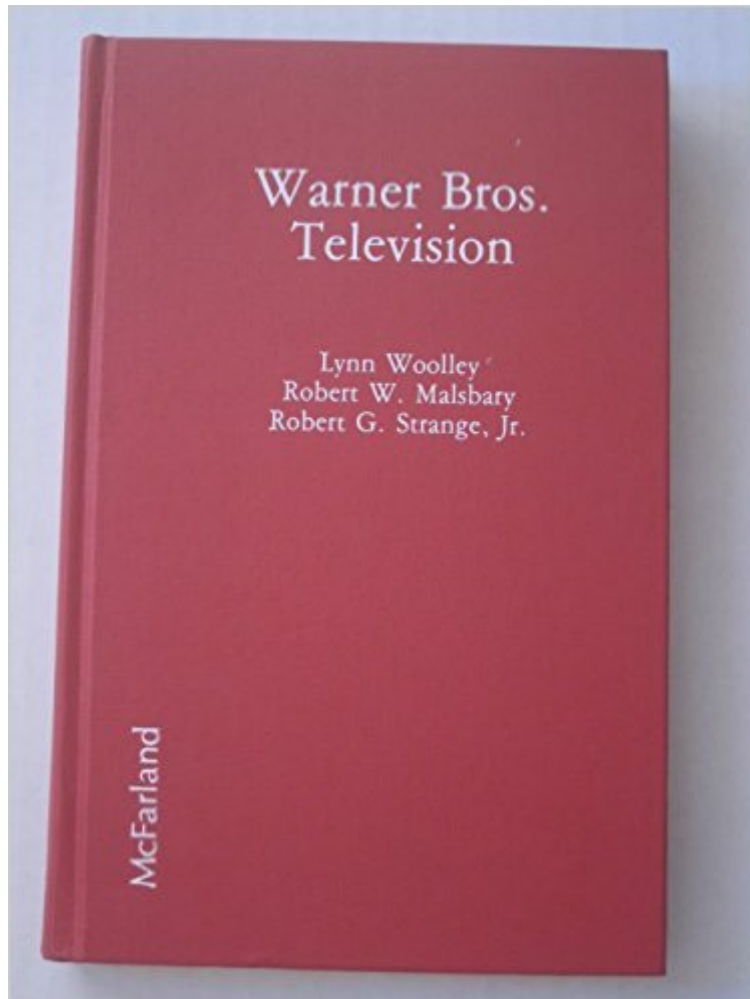

As one who loved the Warner Bros. westerns and detective series that aired (all on ABC) between the mid-1950s and early 1960s, I greatly enjoyed this book. The authors start with a short history of how Warner Bros. studios got involved with the relatively new medium of television. They then go into each Warner Bros. TV series in order of their premiere on TV.. The first show listed is Cheyenne. They give us a short history of the series and biography of the star, Clint Walker. They then follow with a complete description of the plot of each episode of the series in order of their broadcast date.. Occasionally they mention the guest stars in the particular episode. All of the classic Warner Bros. TV series are mentioned including the great westerns: Maverick, Cheyenne, Lawman, Sugarfoot, etc. The great Warner Bros. detective series are also focused upon: 77 Sunset Strip, SurfSide 6, Hawaiian Eye, Bourbon Street Beat plus The Roaring Twenties.. Also the WWII infantry series, The Gallant Men, that premiered the same year as Combat (1962) and, sadly, only lasted 1 season. (My only vague criticism is the non-inclusion of The Dakotas, the excellent Warner Bros. western that replaced Cheyenne on Monday nights.)Not only does this book bring back great memories to those of us who remember watching these series, it could also be useful now that Warner Bros. is opening its vaults and releasing some of their series on DVD like Maverick, Cheyenne and Sugarfoot.In conclusion ,this book is highly recommended: an outstanding job.

An older book, as many of the WB TV stars have since passed on , but still very, very informative for the WB TV fan!
