

Synopsis

This book combines a vast encyclopedic history of the war in Lebanon with a penetrating sociological analysis. The author sets out to answer these and other important questions using a wide range of literature as well as his own extensive research in the country. He writes optimistically, suggesting that although fear can breed a vicious circle of hatred and violence, it can also produce reason and compromise.
