

Each of them has something distinctive to say not only about Liszt, but about him- or herself. Musical examples and other illustrations, as well as photographs of all contributors, provide additional information as well as diversion. Inspired by Schumann: A Chorus of Voices, edited by John C. Tibbetts and published by Amadeus during the 2010 Schumann year, Liszt: A Chorus of Voices will appear during 2011 as No. 12 in the Franz Liszt Studies Series edited by Michael Saffle.
